
OSH and sustainability in global supply chains

- each phase of a supply chain includes work -> this raises the question of occupational safety, health and wellbeing


Why SHW+ in supply chains


- good image and reputation
- greater efficiency and cost savings
- the attraction of talented workers
- less negative publicity
- long-term relationships with supply chain partners and preferred business partnerships
- more resilient supply chains


How to improve safety, health and wellbeing + other fundamental rights in global supply chains?

- Building collaboration and improving SHW+ along supply chain is a long-term process
- Creating sustainable long-term, solution-based, and meaningful collaboration starts from building trust
- One company takes the initiative
 - Defining the supply chain
 - Assessing the existing information about SHW+ in supply chain
 - Contacting the supply chain partners to gather information about SHW+
 - Leads the discussions to collaborate
 - Include more supply chain partners
